A TRIBUTE TO SAINT JOSEPH'S FIRST BENEFACTOR

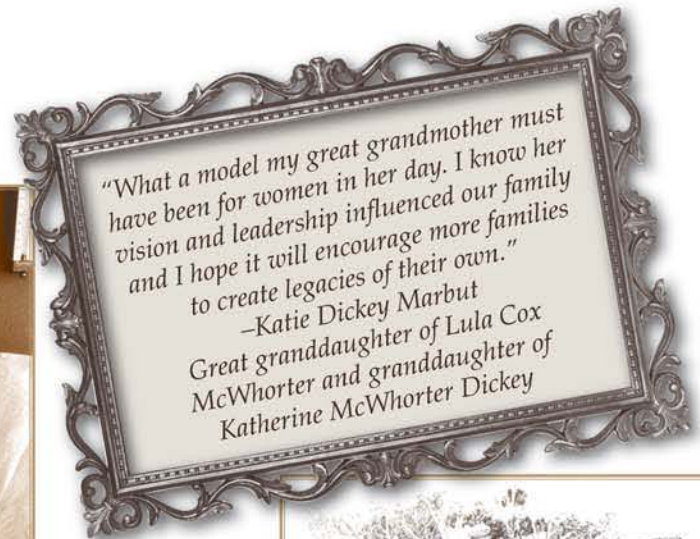
Saint Joseph's Mercy Foundation renamed its Heritage Society the Lula Cox McWhorter Society to honor Saint Joseph's first major benefactor whose kindness, foresight and generosity officially started Saint Joseph's Infirmary in 1885—the precursor of Saint Joseph's Hospital, recognized

as one of the leading adult, acute-care, specialty-referral hospitals in the southeast.

Lula Cox McWhorter, widow of Civil War Major J.H. McWhorter, gave the Sisters of Mercy the land on Courtland Street and \$5,000 to construct a three-story wing onto the original brick house called Atlanta Hospital and founded by the Sisters in 1880. This gift was the first of such magnitude to the Sisters from an outside source, and truly transformational in nature. Mrs. McWhorter's contribution not only took Atlanta's first medical facility to a new level of service to the Atlanta community, but it also paved the way for additional major gifts that have played vital roles in the hospital's development through the years. Such support included gifts from the Spalding, Haverty, Rich and Dickey families.
